Five per cent of these tins were damaged when received owing to faulty manufacture - handles were broken off & the sharp spout had punctured holes in many. For the purpose intended it is considered this tin is a failure.</p> <p>100 Roughly made stretchers issued to this Division for messengers operations that came too late to be used then were returned to Base after being held in store for two months.</p>

Baths & Laundry at Pont de Kieppe were destroyed by enemy shell fire on the 12th of August, as the position had become untenable it was decided not to put them into working order again. Stock, and fittings that were not damaged, was removed & on the 18th Inst. the baths at Steunwerck were taken over by this Division & converted into a laundry, which was started satisfactorily by the 20th Inst. & was a going concern when handed over on the 25th Inst. to the 8th. Division.</p> <p>The building of brigade bath houses & change rooms was undertaken at this time also, & were ready for use when the Division was relieved.</p>
