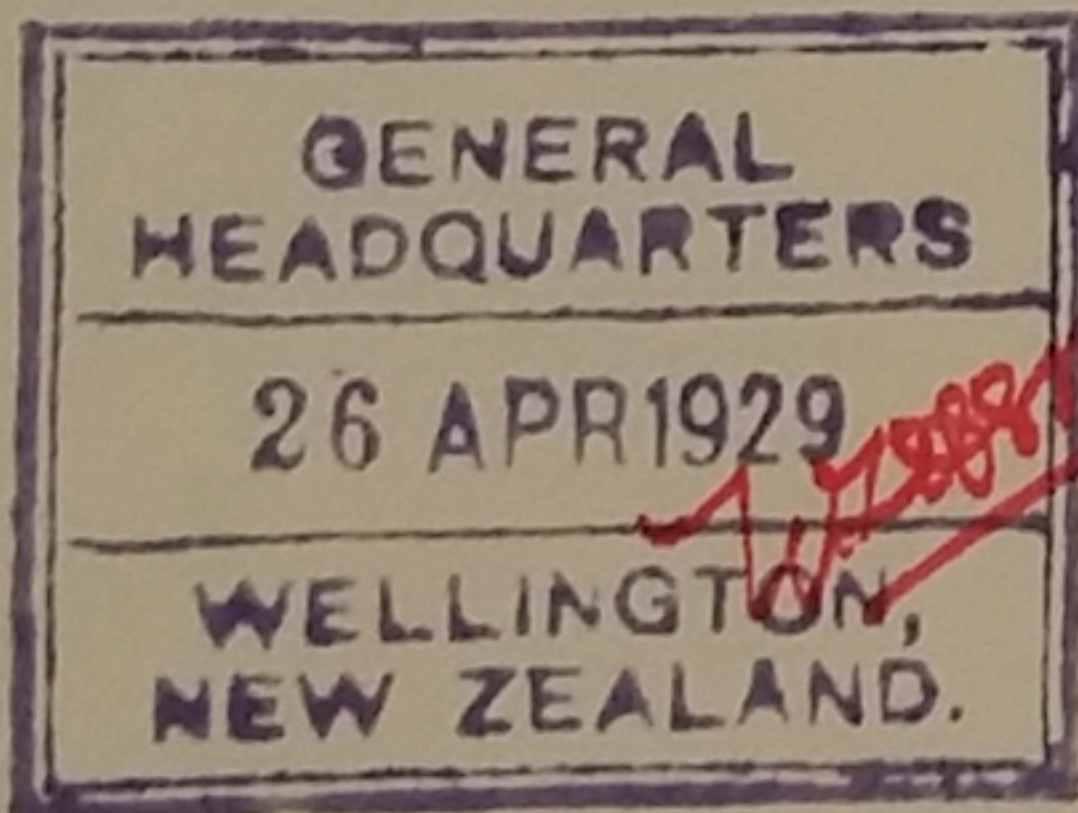
"The following questions have been submitted for a ruling:-

- (a) In the event of requests by the Navy, are members of the Permanent Forces to be permitted as soldiers to take part in games (hockey, football, cricket, etc.), or only at their individual risk?
- (b) Are members of the Permanent Forces, as such, permitted to take part in any organised game (e.g., basket-ball during winter) and, if so, in what capacity - as individuals or as members of the Forces?

"The G.O.C. has given consideration to the matter, and has ruled as follows:-

"In reply to (a), all concerned play at their own risk. They are not to be ordered to play.

"In reply to (b), if they are taking part in an authorised organised game in the course of their duties, viz., when instructing Cadets or Territorials or when under instruction, liability for accident will, subject to the usual conditions, be accepted by the Department. When, however, the game is played merely for exercise or amusement, players will participate at their own risk. "

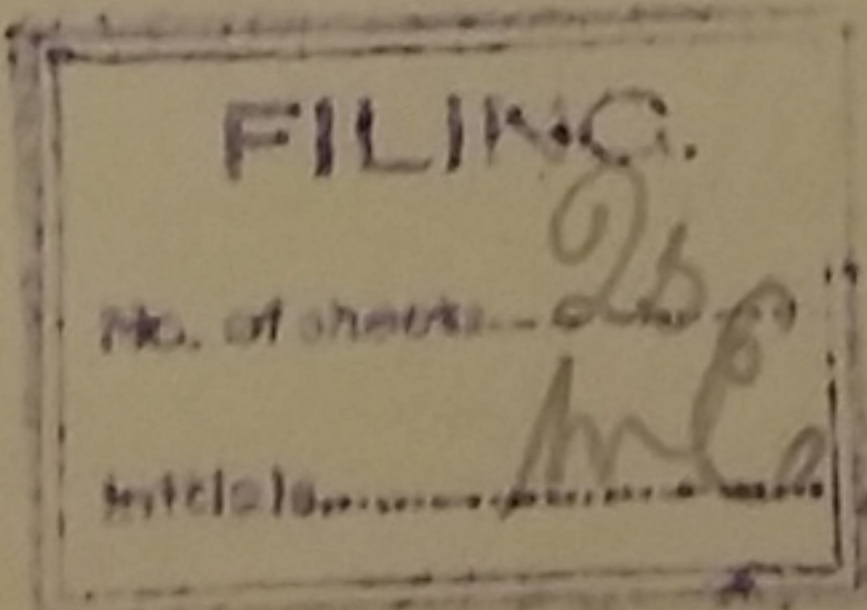
