Visited Maj.. Knox in 62 Gen. Hospital. Interviewed salvage Officer of 70 Div . under whose eommand NZ. Div. Salvage Unit is to function whilst in Tobruk. Obtained clothing and general stores from Adv. Ord. Depot for issue to units. Half the office staff were able to get a swim. Posted Cap.t. R H England as O.C. Div. Ord. Fd. Park (temp) and Lt. B A MeConnell as O.C. No 3 Sect. Div. Ord. Wkshops. (temp). NTew I8 LAD returned from 6 Fd. Regt. as the Regt. was overrun by a tank attack early this morning. The new LAD though only with the Regt. about 6 hours lost one man killed and had two slightly injured. Signalled DDOS. HQ. 2 NZEF for reinforcements.
2. Drew clothing, blankets etc, and distributed to the remnants of Units now in Tobruk. Very little doing in the office.
3. Contacted all Ord. Units in Tobruk and obtained following returns:)
(a) nominal roal, (b) vehicle state, (c) ammunition state. Routine issue of clothing and necessaries to NZ Units. Div. Ord. Fd. Park was instructed to determine the size of any Italian tyres that would fit our vehicles and to salvage as many good and serviceable ones as possible. Stocks were to be eviewed and surplus items were to be returned to Adv. Ord. Depot Tobruk.
4. Little doing in the office as most of the Units are now reasonably well off. Instructed Div. Ord. Wkshops to return two captured A/TK. guns to Adv. Ond. Depot for reissue to 18 Bn . Very cold and miserable day.
